Subject: Full-year Transfers to UC and CSU – 2009-10 to 2010-11

Full-year transfers to the University of California and California State University for 2010-11 were released by the UC Office of the President and the CSU Chancellor's Office. 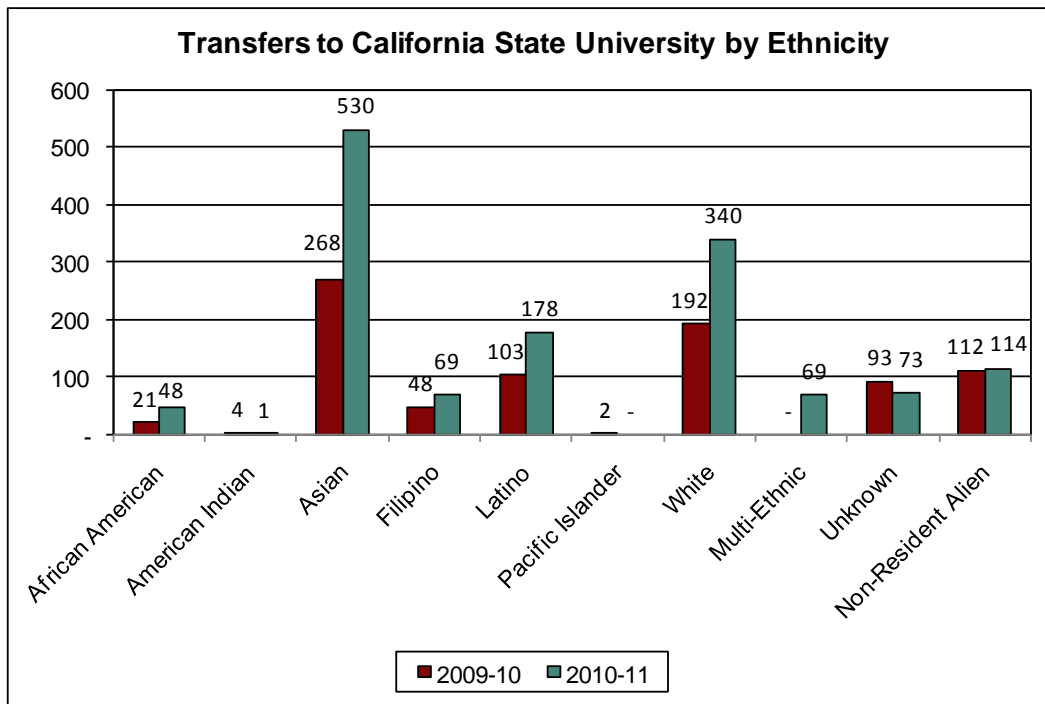

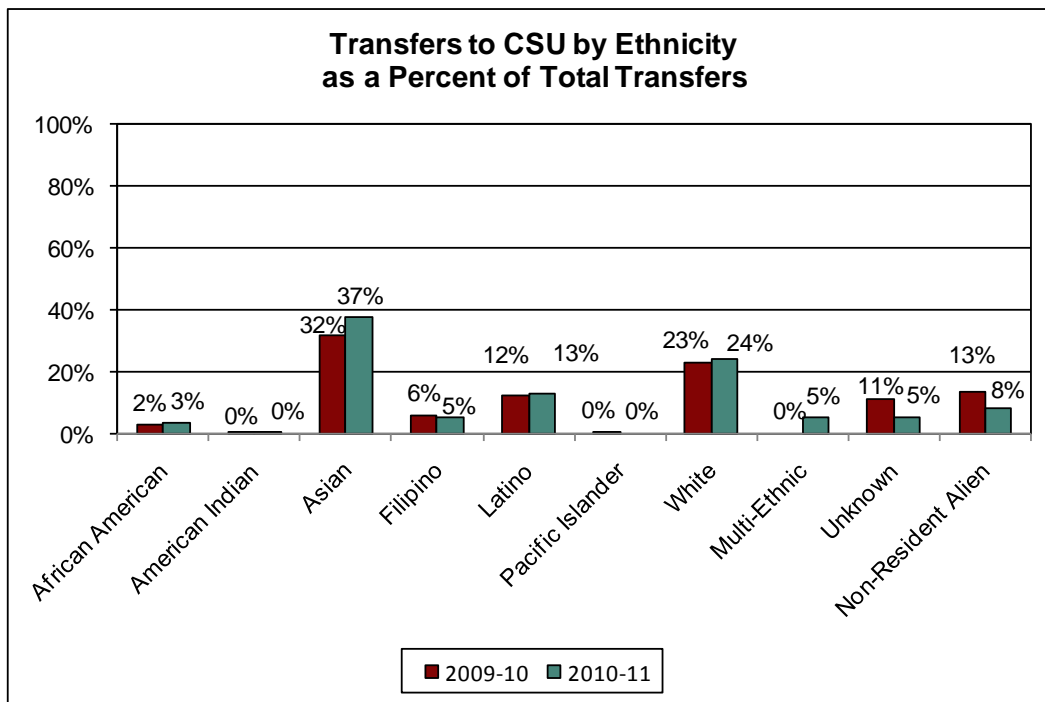
